


Named for the leather pouches carried by frontier explorers to keep critical gear, or “possibles,” in one handy location.




Also available as waterproof Fender Bag.




Upgrade to quick connect Pronghorn Straps for maximum security and stability.



**1** Leave ample room to allow for at least three rolls to seal.



**2** Before rolling, push top down to squeeze air from bag. Roll at least three times.



**3** Holding the rolled ends tight, connect the buckles and cinch straps tightly.

#### MOUNTING TO MOJAVI SADDLEBAG

Thread included webbing straps through the dual loops located under the velcro straps on the Mojavi.





Thread straps through daisy chain loops on Possibles Pouch.



Thread the strap through the buckle as shown.

Place the velcro straps back in place to secure the Mojavi to your motorcycle.

Tighten straps to ensure your Possibles Pouch is secure.



#### PACKING TIPS

- For 100% waterproof protection, roll the top a minimum of 3 rolls.
- Do not overstuff or over-load Possibles Pouch. The challenge should be to pack as little as necessary to be safe, comfortable and self-sufficient. Go light. Go fast. Go far.
- Pack all sharp and/or hard items inside a protective layer. For example, create a sleeve for tire irons from a section of old inner tube, pack tools in rolls and wrap other hard items in clothing.

#### CARING FOR POSSIBLES POUCH™

- Keep away from hot exhaust.
- Avoid sharp metal edges. Protect webbing with inner tube sleeve to prevent abrasion.
- Secure loose webbing ends when riding. Check and retighten all connections at each stop.
- Avoid exposure to insect repellents containing DEET.
- Hand wash Possibles Pouch with mild soap (like Simple Green), rinse with clean water and air dry. DO NOT MACHINE WASH OR DRY.
- Prevent mold, mildew and funky stench by unpacking wet gear, rinsing thoroughly with fresh water and airing dry.
