Off Road Training by Miles Davis from Velo Moto

Thursday September 7

Rides to the Dirty Weekend

- From Sydney: Wisemans Ferry - Nundle – Tingha
- From Brisbane: Ampol Foodary Ripley – Tenterfield – Tingha

Routes will be provided to registered participants before the event to give you time to plan your ride with mates and organise your accommodation at the overnight stop. All riders must start the ride before 9am ahead of the sweep vehicle. In the unlikely event of a breakdown or accident (where Paramedics aren't required) you'll be transported to the next major town along the route where you can organise your own transport either to home or the event.

Friday, September 8

Arrive at Green Valley Farm

- 2:00 pm - Check in at the Gazebo for Camp sites or pre-booked Bunk Rooms where you'll be issued your meal vouchers. The Drink & Snack Tent will be open till 6pm
- 6.00pm to 8.30pm – Dinner (MUST present your **Dinner Ticket** at the snack/drink tent near camp kitchen or no meal 😊)

Please note: For those who aren't camping there is accommodation available in Inverell which is 36 kilometers from Green Valley Farm.

Saturday, September 9

Dirty Weekend Main Event

- 7.00am to 9.00am – Breakfast (Must present your **Breakfast Ticket** at the wool shed)

- 8:30am to 1pm – On Property Enduro Loop-This loop will be run with the Green Valley property boundaries and features fire trails, hill climbs, creek crossings and scenic vistas. It's not considered to be too technical, will use the cornerman system and is restricted to twenty riders. Recommended for mid-sized adventure bikes (eg DR650, KTM 690, Tenere). The riders briefing is at 8:30am for a 9am start.
- 9:00am to 4:00pm – Visit including Rideadv.com.au, Ducati Riding Experience, Vince Strang Suzuki industry Trade Displays
- 9:00am to 2:30pm - Self Guided Local Region Adventure Ride - Our hosts at Green Valley Farm have planned out a self-guided adventure ride loop and explore the best adventure roads in the region. Take advantage of local knowledge and follow the route sheet which will take you about 3-4 hours at a leisurely pace.
- 9.45am to 10.15am – Miles Davis skills demonstration (Part 1)
- 12.00pm – Drink and Snack Tent operating
